# TYPES OF CORRELATION

- FOUR TYPE OF CORRELATION IN TEACHING OF COMMERCE-
  - VERTICAL CORRELATION
  - HORIZONTAL CORRELATION
  - INCIDENTAL CORRELATION
  - PLANNED CORRELATION
  - CORRELTION WITH REAL LIFE

# VERTICAL CORRELATION

- VERTICAL CORRELATION INDICATES RELATIONSHIP IN VARIOUS BRANCHES OF A PARTICULAR SUBJECT.
- TEACHER CAN TAKE HELP OF VERTICAL CORRELATION TO MAKE HIS STUDENTS UNDERSTAND ABOUT TRADE , INTERNAL TRADE AND EXTERNAL TRADES ALONG WITH IMPORT AND EXPORT PROCEDURE ETC.

## CONTD..

- **TEACHER CAN EASILY MAKE HIS STUDENTS UNDERSTAND ABOUT HOW THE VARIOUS CONCEPTS ARE INTERRELATED WITH EACH OTHER.**

# HORIZONTAL CORRELATION

- HORIZONTAL CORRELATION INDICATES HOW THE KNOWLEDGE OF VARIOUS SUBJECTS CAN BE CORRELATED WHEN THE COMMERCE TEACHER CORRELATES THE KNOWLEDGE OF COMMERCE SUBJECT WITH THE KNOWLEDGE OF VARIOUS OTHER SUBJECTS I.E. ECONOMICS, HISTORY, GEOGRAPHY.

- WHILE TEACHING ABOUT INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT, TEACHER CAN USE THE KNOWLEDGE OF HISTORY SUBJECT TO DISCUSS ABOUT VARIOUS ASPECTS OF HISTORICAL PLACES AND IMPORTANCE OF THESE INDUSTRIES AND IT'S HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT ( IF ANY ).
